Defining Plagiarism

In an instructional setting, plagiarism occurs when a writer **deliberately** uses someone else's language, ideas, or other original (not common-knowledge) material without acknowledging its source.

--from *Defining and Avoiding Plagiarism:
The WPA Statement on Best Practices*

What gets plagiarised?

How to plagiarize a paper

- Download a free essay from the internet
- Purchase a paper from a commercial paper mill
- Copy an article (or articles) from online sources
- Copy a paper from a classmate
- Fake your citations





WPA Shared Responsibilities: Faculty

- Build support for researched writing
- Communicate policies & expectations
- Teach writing conventions and allow students to practice
- Avoid recycled or formulaic assignments
- Engage students in the process
- Discuss problems and offer strategies
- Determine if papers are the result of a deliberate attempt to deceive
- Report cases of academic dishonesty



Contextualize writing prompts



Tailor assignments to the content of your course

Use unusual combinations of texts

Ask students to make interdisciplinary connections

Use Blackboard discussions as a source

Provide an authentic audience

Write an editorial

Contribute to a Wikipedia article

Write a proposal to the Board of Trustees

- Deliver oral report on readings and analysis of free essay

The Un-Research Paper

Part 1: Brief essay on any topic

- Don't do research
- Don't cite sources
- Don't use quotes
- Don't worry (much) about accuracy

Part 2: Annotated Bibliography

- One source that supports a point
- One source that adds new information
- One source that reveals an inaccuracy
- One quote from a source that would enhance the essay

Improve the Design and Sequence of Assignments

- Design assignments that require students to explore a subject in depth.
- Start building possible topics early.
- Consider establishing a course theme.
- Develop schedules for students that allow them time to explore.
- Support each step of the research process.
- Make the research process, and technology used for it, visible.
- Attend to conventions of different genres of writing.


